Now Jesus went with his disciples to the villages of Caesarea Philippi and on the way he asked his disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" And they answered, saying, "John the Baptizer and others, Elijha; and still others, one of the prophets." He asked them, "But who do you all say that I am?" Peter answered him, "You are the Messiah." And he warned them so they would tell no one about him. Then Jesus began to teach them that the Son of Woman must undergo great suffering, and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scholars, and be killed, and after three days rise again. And he boldly said this thing. Then Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. But turning and looking at his disciples, Jesus rebuked Peter and he said, "Get behind me, Satan! --because the mind is not on that which is God's, rather on that which is mortal." And Jesus called the crowd along with his disciples, and said to those women and men, "If any want to follow after me, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me.
