## Charitable bequests can take various forms.


You may leave a bequest of a specific sum of money, a percentage of your estate, or the residual of your estate.

Gifts may be unrestricted, to be used for the area(s) of greatest need, or restricted for specific purposes, including but not limited to existing endowment funds.

Gifts from past legacy donors have contributed to the maintenance and beautification of our historic church building, upgraded the pipe organ in our sanctuary, brought nationally recognized authors and theologians to provide programming, and helped ensure a balanced annual church budget.

## To leave a legacy

Our desire is to help you align your charitable goals with the church's ministries that have the greatest meaning for you and to incorporate those goals within your estate planning documents.
